The Subject Property consists of approximately 0.101 acres of land and is located within the "R-3 multi-household dwelling district" of the City of Central Falls' Zoning Map. The Subject Property is located conveniently near shops and eateries on Broad Street.

Currently situated upon the Subject Property is a four (4) family residential structure that was built in 1900. The residential structure has 3,002 square feet of living space, consisting of sixteen (16) total rooms, including five (5) bedrooms, and four (4) full bathrooms. Electricity for the Subject Property is provided by National Grid. Sewer services are provided by the Narragansett Bay Commission, and water is provided by the Pawtucket Water Supply Board.
